The LORD calls Zion to LISTEN UP, WAKE UP and GO OUT with confidence because He reigns and will deliver them.

Zion would be delivered from Babylon, and ultimately will be from the four corners of the earth.

Today we must look to what Abraham has found, righteousness by faith (Romans 4:1-5); believe and proclaim the good news of the gospel of Jesus Christ (Romans 10:15); and “come out” from the defilements of the world looking forward to the ultimate restoration in the kingdom (2 Cor. 5:14-18).
