*In this book of the “seven signs,” John specifically selected these “So that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name.” 20:31*

*As the Christ or Messiah, He was showing a glimpse of the kingdom and “banquet of aged wine” to come (Isaiah 25:6). He is also referred to as the “Bridegroom” (4:29), and so His presence and enrichment of this wedding pictures His “marriage supper” to come.*
